- A birtokos esetet birtoklás kifejezésére használjuk, a főnév végén egy 's hozzáadásával.
Ha a főnév többes számban van, csak a 't tesszük ki.

This is Tom's book. It's Tom's. Ez Tom könyve.
Ez Tomé.

This is my sister's pencil. Ez a testvérem ceruzája.

My parents' computer is black. A szüleim számítógépe fekete.

- A közelre mutató névmások a "this" és "these":
These are my books. Ezek a könyveim.
- A távolra mutató névmások a "that" és "those".
Those boys over there are my friends. Azok a fiúk ott a barátaim.
- Eberekre, állatokra és tárgyakra egyaránt utalhatnak.

A "have got" ige

- A "have got" igét használjuk:
 - birtoklás kifejezésére.
I've got a computer. Van egy számítógépem.
 - családi kapcsolatok kifejezésére.
He's got two brothers. Két bátyja van.
 - emberek, állatok jellemzésére.
Mary has got fair hair. Marynek világos haja van.

a table - two tables
- **A megszámlálhatatlan főneveknek** csak egyes számú alakjuk van, nem lehet őket többes számba tenni. Nem használhatunk előttük határozatlan névelőt, vagy számot.

- A **"some"** használható megszámlálhatatlan és megszámlálható főnevek előtt egyaránt, kijelentő mondatokban, illetve kínálás esetén.
There are some carrots in the fridge. Van pár répa a hűtőben.

Would you like some orange juice? Kérsz egy kis narancslevet?

- Az **“any”** megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt és többes számú megszámlálható főnevek előtt állhat tagadó és kérdő mondatokban.

Is there any milk in the fridge? Van tej a hűtőben?

There aren't any apples in the fridge. Nincs alma a hűtőben.

- Az **“a lot of / lots of”** kifejezések állhatnak megszámlálható és megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt is.

I eat a lot of / lots of fruit. Rengeteg gyümölcsöt eszek.

I eat a lot of / lots of apples. Rengeteg almát eszek.

This soup is delicious. Taste it! Ez a leves finom. Kóstold meg (azt).

How much...? / How many...?

- A **“How much”** kérdőszót megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt használjuk, mennyiségre kérdezve.
How much water is in the bottle? Mennyi víz van az üvegben?
- A **“How many”** kérdőszó megszámlálható főnevekre utal, és darabszámmra kérdezzük vele.
How many students are there in the classroom? Hány diák van a teremben?

- A **folyamatos jelen** igeidőt a beszéd pillanatában éppen történő cselekvések kifejezésére használjuk.
John is watching TV now. John épp tévét néz.
Listen! She is playing the piano. Hallgasd csak!
Zongorázik.
- Az **egyszerű jelen** igeidőt szokásos, ismétlődő cselekvések és állapotok kifejezésére használjuk.
John watches TV at the weekend. John hétvégén tévét szokott nézni.
He plays the piano every day. Minden nap zongorázik.

A folyamatos jelen igeidő is kifejezhet jövő idejű terveket: We are having a party next Saturday. Jövő szombaton bulit tartunk.

- Amikor összehasonlítunk két tárgyat, embert, fogalmat egymással, a mellékneveket fokozzuk, közép vagy felsőfokot használva.

Everybody is in the living room. Mindenki a nappaliban van.
Is everybody in the living room? Mindenki a nappaliban van?

A will segédigét használjuk jövő idő kifejezésére:

- azonnali döntések esetén
Don’t worry. I’ll come shopping with you. Ne aggódj, elmegyek veled vásárolni.
- javaslatoknál
I’ll help you with everything. Mindenben segítek neked.
