I watch TV every day. Minden nap TV-t nézek.  
She goes out at the weekend. Minden hétvégén elmegy szórakozni.
- általános cselekvések, állapotok kifejezésére.  
We live in Boston. Bostonban élünk.  
I like ice cream. Szeretem a fagyaltot.

- napirend, órarend, menetrend esetén.  
She starts work at 8.30 every day. Minden nap 8.30-kor kezd.

- A **folyamatos jelen** igeidőt a beszéd pillanatában éppen történő cselekvések kifejezésére használjuk.  
John is watching TV now. John épp tévét néz.

Listen! She is playing the piano. Hallgasd csak!  
Zongorázik.

- Az **egyszerű jelen** igeidőt szokásos, ismétlődő cselekvések és állapotok kifejezésére használjuk.  
John watches TV at the weekend. John hétvégén tévét szokott nézni.  
He plays the piano every day. Minden nap zongorázik.

Az egyszerű múlt igeidőt használjuk:

- meghatározott múlt időben történt cselekvések, történések kifejezésére.  
We bought our house five years ago. 5 éve vettük a házunkat.
- Múlt idejű szokásos és ismétlődő cselekvések kifejezésére.  
I always went to bed early when I lived with my parents. Mikor a szüleimmel éltem, mindig korán feledtem le aludni.
- Egymás után történt múlt idejű cselekvések esetén (pl. felsorolás)  
Yesterday I got up at 8.00, had breakfast and left for school. Tegnap 8-kor felkeltem, megreggeliztem és elmentem az iskolába.

Amikor -e betűre végződik a melléknév, nem írunk még egyet:	nice -> nicer -> the nicest
Egy szótagú melléknevek esetében, ha egy magánhangzó+egy mássalhangzóra végződnek, akkor az utolsó mássalhangzó megkettőződik.	hot -> hotter -> the hottest

A **Will** segédigét használjuk jövő idő kifejezésére:

- jóslatok kifejezésére, jellemzően a think és believe igékkel  
I think he will be a great actor one day.  
Szerintem nagyszerű színész lesz egy nap.
- azonnali döntések esetén.  
Fine, I'll meet you in an hour. Rendben, egy óra múlva találkozunk.
- kínálás, felajánlás kifejezésére.  
I'll help you with everything. Segítek neked mindenben.
- figyelmeztetések esetén.  
Be quiet or I'll tell the teacher. Legyél csöndben, vagy megmondalak a tanárnak.
- ígéretes kifejezésére  
I promise, I'll be there for you. Megígérem, számíthatsz rám.
- udvarias kéréseknél  
Will you do me a favour? Megteszel nekem egy szívességet?

### may/might/could segédigék

A may, might and could segédigék:

- után az ige jelen idejű alakja áll, ragozás nélkül
- nincs más alakjuk
- tagadásuk a not szó hozzáadásával történik
- mindhárom segédigével jelen vagy jövő időre utalhatunk, és lehetőséget fejezhetünk ki. A might fejezi ki a legkevesebb eséllyel bekövetkező lehetőséget.  
We may/might/could go to the Summer Festival next weekend. Lehet, hogy elmegyünk a Nyári Fesztiválra jövő héten.
- A may és might segédigék tagadó alakja a lehetőség hiányára utal.  
Henry may not/might not come to the park.  
Henry lehet, hogy nem jön a parkba.

A befejezett jelen igeidő használata:

- Olyan múltban történt cselekvések, történések esetén, amelyekhez nem kötődik konkrét időpont.  
I've visited the National History Museum, so I don't want to go there again. Már voltam a Természettudományi Múzeumban. Nem akarok megint menni.
- Olyan múltban történt cselekvések, történések esetén, melyek a jelenre hatással vannak.  
Look! Jerry has broken his leg! Nézd! Jerry eltörte a lábát!

**FONTOS**

- A **have/has gone** jelentése: elment, és még mindig ott van.  
Lisa has gone to the supermarket. (She's still there.) Lisa elment a boltba. (Még most is ott van)
- A **have/has been** jelentése: elment valahová/volt valahol, és már visszaért.  
Lisa has been to Barcelona. (Now she's back.) Lisa már volt Barcelonában. (És most nincs ott).

**yet/already**

- A **yet** csak kérdő és tagadó mondatban fordul elő, a mondat végén.  
Have you finished yet? Befejezted már?  
He hasn't arrived yet. Még nem érkezett meg.
- Az **already** kijelentő és kérdő mondatokban állhat, a segédige és a főige között, vagy hangsúly kifejezése esetén a mondat végén.  
I've already seen that film. Már láttam azt a filmet.  
Have you finished eating already? Már befejezted az evést?

**Befejezett jelen és a since/for/how long**

Múltban kezdődő és jelenig tartó cselekvésekre, történésekre utalva használjuk.

	How long have you had this car? Mióta van meg az autód?
since + az időtartam kezdete (e.g since 1980, since yesterday, since last week, since 4 a.m.)	I've had this car since 1999. 1999 óta van meg az autóm.
for + az időtartam hossza (e.g for two weeks, for three days, for _ive minutes, for months)	I've had this car for six years. Hat éve van meg az autóm.

**“ugye?” kérdés**

Rövid utókérdés a kérdőmondat végén, megerősítésre utal. Az angol nyelvben képzése a főmondat nyelvtani szerkezetéhez igazodik.

You couldn't see her, could you? Nem láttad őt, ugye?

Tom believed him, didn't he? Tom hitt neki, ugye?

- Amikor a főmondat igéje állító, az utókérdés tagadó:  
The boys are at school, aren't they? A fiúk iskolában vannak, ugye?
- Amikor a főmondat igéje tagadó alakú, az utókérdés állító:  
She hasn't seen the doctor yet, has she? Még nem volt orvosnál, ugye?

## A **should** segédigét használjuk:

- tanács, javaslat kérések, adásakor  
A: What should I do? Mit tegyek?  
B: You shouldn't work so hard. Nem kellene olyan keményen dolgoznod.
- vélemény kifejezésére  
I think the children should eat more fruit.  
Szerintem a gyerekeknek több gyümölcsöt kellene enniük.
- ötlet, javaslat esetén  
We should go bowling tonight. Menjünk bowlingozni ma este.

## too/enough

- A **too** (túlságosan, túl) melléknevek és határozók előtt állhat.  
This coffee is too hot. I can't drink it. Ez a kávé túl meleg. Nem tudom meginni.
- Az **enough** (elég, eléggé) melléknevek és határozók után áll, viszont főnevek előtt.  
The weather is warm enough for a picnic. Elég meleg az idő egy piknikhez.  
There's enough food in the fridge. Van elég étel a hűtőben.

## How much...?/How many...?/Much/Many/ A lot of/Lots of/A little/A few

- A **How much** (mennyi?) kérdőszót megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt használjuk, mennyiségre kérdezve.  
How much water is in the bottle? Mennyi víz van az üvegben?

### FONTOS

A How much...? kérdőszóval árakra is kérdezhetünk  
How much are these shoes? £100? Mennyibe kerül a cipő?

- A **How many** (hány?) kérdőszó megszámlálható főnevekre utal, és darabszámra kérdezünk vele.  
How many cans of lemonade do we need? Hány doboz limonádéra van szükségünk?
- A **much** (sok) megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt általában kérdő és tagadó mondatokban használható.  
We haven't got much money. Nincs sok pénzünk.
- A **many** (sok) megszámlálható főnevek előtt áll, általában kérdő és tagadó mondatokban  
There aren't many books in the bookcase. Nincs sok könyv a könyvespolcon.
- Az **a lot of/lots of** (sok, rengeteg) megszámlálható és megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt egyaránt állhat, általában kijelentő mondatokban.  
There is a lot of coffee in my cup. Sok kávé van a bögrémben.  
There are lots of eggs in the fridge. Sok tojás van a hűtőben.
- Az **a little** (kevés, egy kis) megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt használható.  
There is a little cheese on the table. Van egy kis sajt az asztalon.
- Az **a few** (egy pár, egy kevés) többesszámú megszámlálható főnevek előtt áll.  
There are a few magazines on the table. Van pár újság az asztalon.

## one/ones

- Szóismétlés kerülésére használhatjuk megszámlálható főnevek helyett egyes vagy többes számban.

Which bag is yours? The black one. Melyik táska a tiéd? A fekete (táska).

Which books do you like? The ones about history. Melyik könyveket szereted? A történelemről szóló (könyveket).

### Birtokos személyjelek és birtokos névmások

- A birtokos személyjelek után mindig áll főnév, de névelő nem állhat előttük.  
Her hat is green. Az ő kalapja zöld.
- A birtokos névmások önállóan állnak, nincs utánuk a birtokolt főnév. Rövid válaszokban és kérdésekben fordulnak gyakran elő.  
Your bag is brown, but mine is black. A te táskád barna, de az enyém fekete.  
That cat is hers. Az a macska az övé.  
Whose is this ball? It's his. Kié ez a labda? Az övé.

## Module 4

### Vonatkozó névmások (who, which, that)

- Jelzői mellékmondatokban utalnak a főmondat tárgyára vagy alanyára.
- A vonatkozó névmás elhagyható a mondatból, ha utána közvetlenül alany következik.  
Mrs Robins is the teacher. I like her the most.  
Mrs Robins a tanár. Őt szeretem legjobban.  
Mrs Robins is the teacher (who) I like the most.  
Mrs Robins a tanár, akit a legjobban szeretek.

### Full Infinitive

To+ige szótári alakja  
Többek között célhatározói mellékmondatokban használjuk.  
I'm going to the market to get some fruit. Megyek piacra, (azért) hogy vegyek gyümölcsöt.  
Mr Robins went to the newsagent's to buy a newspaper. Mr Robins elment az újságoshoz, (azért) hogy vegyen újságot.
