# Grammar Reference

## Hello

### Plural nouns (többesszámú főnevek, nem rendhagyók)

- A nem rendhagyó főnevek többes számát "s" hozzáadásával képezzük.  
book -> books  
chair -> chairs

### a / an (egy – határozatlan névelő)

- "a" névelőt használunk, amikor mássalhangzóval kezdődik a következő szó. (s, t, x. . . ).  
a book, a pencil
- "an" névelőt használunk, amikor a következő szó magánhangzóval kezdődik. (a, e, i, o, u).  
an orange, an apple

### This / That (ez, az – mutató névmás)

- This:** mutató névmás, hozzánk közel eső tárgyra vagy személyre mutatva használjuk.  
*This is a book. Ez egy könyv.*
- That:** mutató névmás, hozzánk távolabb eső tárgyra vagy személyre mutatva használjuk.  
*That girl over there is Maria. Az a lány Maria.*

### Felszólító mód

- Felszólító módot az ige szótári alakjával képezzük, minden változtatás nélkül. A tiltást a don't tiltó szó vezeti be.  
*Read the text! Don't speak!*  
*Olvasd el a szöveget! Ne beszélj!*
- Felszólító módot használunk akkor is, ha megkérünk valakit valamire. A please szó udvariasabbá teszi a kérést.  
*Open your books, please. Kérlek, nyissátok ki a könyveiteket.*

*This is Tom's book. Ez Tom könyve.*
- a főnév végén egy 's hozzáadásával.
- Ha a főnév többes számban van, csak a '-t tesszük ki.  
*This is my sister's pencil. Ez a testvérem ceruzája.*  
*My parents' car is white. A szüleim autója fehér.*

*These are my books. Ezek a könyveim.*
- Emberekre, állatokra, tárgyakra mutathatunk velük távolabbra.  
*Those boys over there are my friends. Azok a fiúk ott a barátaim.*

Mássalhangzó + y-ra végződő igék helyesírása: "y" lemarad, helyette: "ies"	<i>I study -&gt; he studies DE I play -&gt; he plays</i>

- ismétlődő, szokásos cselekvések kifejezésére használjuk.  
*I watch TV every day. Minden nap TV-t nézek.*  
*She studies at the weekend. Hétfőig tanulni szokott.*

### love/enjoy/like/hate

- like/love/enjoy/hate + **főnév**:  
*I love my family. Szeretem a családom.*  
*Pablo hates basketball. Pablo utálja a kosárlabdát.*
- like/love/enjoy/hate + **"-ing"-es alak**:  
*Maria loves swimming. Maria szereti az úszást.*  
*I hate doing my homework. Utálom a házi feladat írását.*

*Are there two armchairs in the room? Van két fotel a szobában?*

### Névelők (a/an/the)

- A határozatlan névelőket (a/an) egyes számú főnevek előtt használjuk, mikor első alkalommal említjük őket, és nem egy bizonyos főnévre utalunk. Az „a” után mássalhangzóval kezdődő főnév jön, míg az „an” után magánhangzó következik.  
*There is a lamp in the room. Van egy lámpa a szobában.*  
*There isn't an armchair in the room. Nincs egy fotel sem a szobában.*
- A határozott névelőt (**the**) egyes és többes számú főnevek előtt is használhatjuk, amikor egy bizonyos dologra utalunk.  
*The black car is my father's. A fekete autó apukámé.*

### Let's...

- Javaslatot tehetünk a **Let's** szócskával:  
*Let's play basketball. Let's go out tonight.*  
*Kosarazzunk! Menjünk el ma este valahova!*

- engedélyt adhatunk, vagy visszavonhatunk: *Yes, you can./ No, you can't. Igen, elmehetsz. Nem, nem mehetsz el.*
- Kérhetünk is (általánosságban): *Can I have a glass of orange juice, please? Kaphatok egy pohár narancslevet?*

A **Can** egy segédige, nem ragozható, és a tagadása a not szóval történik.

## Module 5

### Megszámlálható és megszámlálhatatlan főnevek

- A megszámlálható főneveknek van egyes és többes számú alakja is. Határozatlan névelő és szám is használható előttük.  
*a table - two tables*
- A megszámlálhatatlan főneveknek csak egyes számú alakjuk van, nem lehet őket többes számba tenni. Nem használhatunk előttük határozatlan névelőt, vagy számot.  
*coffee - sugar - milk*
- Megszámlálható főnevek előtt nem használunk számnevet vagy névelőt, hanem a *some/any* szavakat.  
A: *Is there any milk? Van tej?*  
B: *No, but there's some coffee. Nincs, de van egy kis kávé.*

### Would like

- Kínálásnál használhatjuk a **Would you like...?** kifejezést.  
*Would you like some coffee? Kérsz egy kis kávé?*
- Ha udvariasan kérni szeretnénk valamit, akkor a **I would like / I'd like** kifejezéseket használjuk.  
*I'd like some coffee, please. Kérek egy kis kávé.*

### Some / Any

- A "some" használható megszámlálhatatlan és megszámlálható főnevek előtt egyaránt, kijelentő mondatokban, illetve kínálás esetén.  
*There are some carrots in the fridge. Van pár répa a hűtőben.*

*Would you like some orange juice? Kérsz egy kis narancslevet?*

- Az "any" megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt és többes számú megszámlálható főnevek előtt állhat tagadó és kérdő mondatokban.

*Is there any milk in the fridge? Van tej a hűtőben?*  
*There aren't any apples in the fridge. Nincs alma a hűtőben.*

### How much / How many

- A "How much" kérdőszót megszámlálhatatlan főnevek előtt használjuk, mennyiségre kérdezve.  
*How much water is in the bottle? Mennyi víz van az üvegben?*
- A "How many" kérdőszó megszámlálható főnevekre utal, és darabszámba kérdezzük vele.  
*How many students are there in the classroom? Hány diák van a teremben?*

### Személyes névmások, tárgyeset

*She's talking on the phone. Telefonál.*

Helyesírási szabályok	
a legtöbb ige változatlan marad az -ing előtt	talk -> talking
ha -e betűre végződik az ige, akkor az lemarad, és így követi az -ing	come -> coming
az egy szótagú szavak esetében, ha egy magánhangzó+egy mássalhangzóra végződnek, akkor az utolsó mássalhangzó megkettőződik.	stop -> stopping
két vagy több szótagú szavak esetében, ha hangsúlyos magánhangzó+egy mássalhangzóra végződnek, akkor az utolsó mássalhangzó megkettőződik.	begin -> beginning DE happen -> happening
egy magánhangzó+"l" betűre végződő szavak esetén az "l" megkettőződik.	l -> travelling
az -ie végződésű szavak vége -y betűre változik	lie -> lying

### A folyamatos és egyszerű jelen igeidő

- A **folyamatos jelen** igeidőt a beszéd pillanatában éppen történő cselekvések kifejezésére használjuk.  
*John is watching TV now. John épp tévét néz.*  
*Listen! She is playing the piano. Hallgasd csak! Zongorázik.*
- Az **egyszerű jelen** igeidőt szokásos, ismétlődő cselekvések és állapotok kifejezésére használjuk.  
*John watches TV at the weekend. John hétvégén tévét szokott nézni.*  
*He plays the piano every day. Minden nap zongorázik.*
